10Radio is based at Wiveliscombe House in Wivey town centre and if you want to see the station in action, you can come along and meet the presenters and back room helpers.

Many have already done this and some are now presenting their own unique programmes.

Or you contact 10Radio on 01984 624772 to make music requests or join in the lively chitchat and discussions via regular programme 'phone-ins' - or even decide you want to present a show yourself.

10Radio's programme schedule has something for all tastes and all age groups, from Mondays to Fridays:

#### 7am-9am

Early morning with a lively breakfast show of music, local news, thought for today and interviews plus updates of what's hap-

pening in the area, weather wise and our unique Surf News.

#### 9am-10am

Local Arts, Poetry/ events/ local business etc.

#### 10am-12 noon

Hosted music programmes covering Classical, Jazz, Films, Blues, R&B or simply chill out sounds for the over 50s.

#### 12 noon-1.30pm

Ralph's Community; where you the listener can join in, and if you wish, take over. Ralph will be inviting a selection of local people to talk about their lives past and present with, of course, music.

#### 1.30pm-2pm

The first programme of the day with content provided entirely by Kingsmead students. One wonders if future entertainers/broadcasters will have first hit the airwaves via 10Radio?

#### 2pm-4pm

Afternoon with Jez - seasoned 10Radio music presenter - with music for all ages, requests played, chat etc.

#### 4pm-5.30pm

The Kingsmead After School Show - the second student take-over of the day with their music, interviews and youthful antics.

#### 5.30pm-7pm

Drive Home Show or Kate Whitfield's Community. Similar to Ralph - but we are talking Pinky Kate here, so look out for musical fun, gossip as well as something called 'Ask Aunty Kate and Uncle Eddie' - your problems solved'...but only on

Hosted Music and Chat from various presenters.

#### 8pm-10pm

More themed chat and music shows such as on Mondays - World / Roots Music; Football and Competitions phone-in on Tuesdays; Ted's Live Music Scene on Wednesdays; Thursday is the Anarchist Jukebox, and it's full blown Bantering on Fridays!

#### 10pm-Midnight

More hosted music - all kinds of Vinyl and CD racks searched and brought to the 10Radio area. Finally there are the post midnight Secret Sessions for insomniacs or night workers.

The weekends are bringing slightly different, but similarly varied, live programme content.

10Radio is publishing daily content in local papers and on posters around the area, or you can view the full schedule on the 10Radio website.

NOT for funds this time, as thanks to the generosity of local people the refurbishment of the hall was completed; any Stage 2 major improvements will have to wait for a while.

The committee now wants to encourage more use of the hall so that running costs can be more or less covered.

The committee will continue to run events but they are keen to hear ideas from local people.

The hall is available for private hire such as children's parties, tabletop sales, coffee mornings, busi-

ness meetings and club meetings.

Would equipment like a table tennis table or large-scale children's games encourage more use?

The fee is still £10 a session (morning, afternoon or

evening) or £5 an hour. However, the huge rise in energy costs means that this may well be reviewed in 2007.
