and tricks, and of course pitfalls to be avoided.

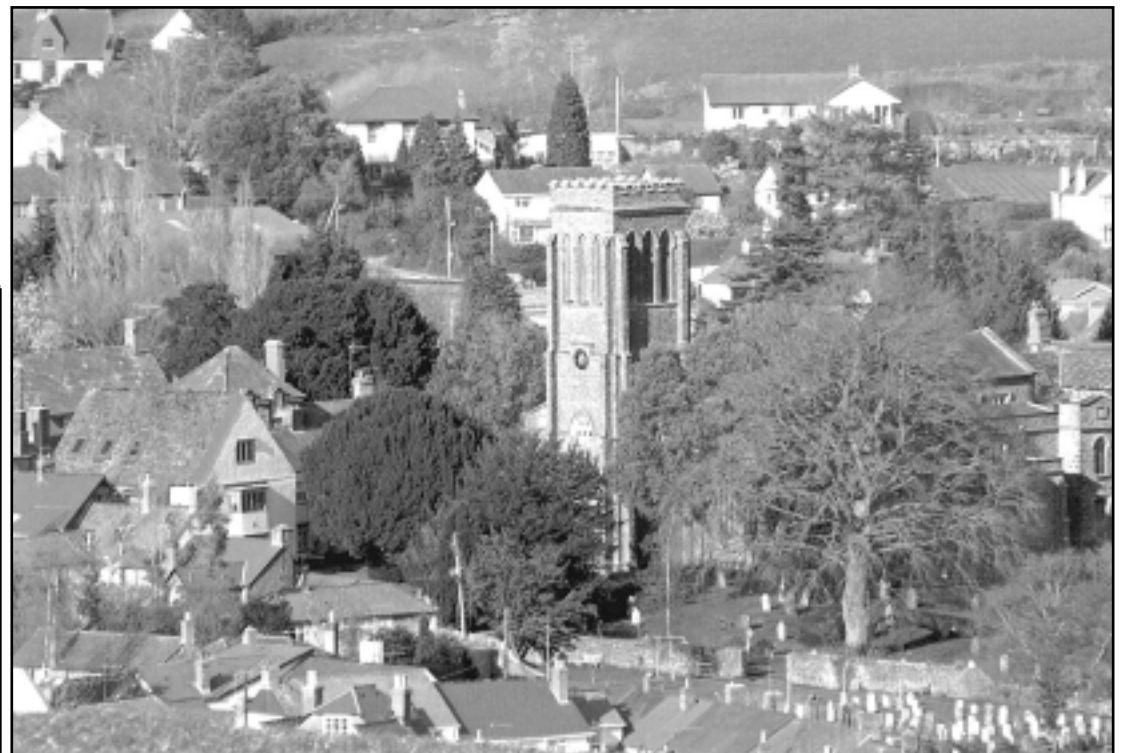
Both film and digital photography is discussed, as well as related subjects such as photo storage, manipulation and printing through your own home computer.
