Membership Notes

1. A family constitutes a maximum of two adults and two children over 5 who reside at the same address, additional children between 5 and 17 years can be included at a further cost of £5 per head, under 5's are free.
2. Adult membership applies to those over 18. However, young adults, under 22 years and in full time education, can be included in a family membership or may pay at the Junior membership rate.
3. OAP concessions apply to over 60's, membership will be at the Junior rate.
4. Membership cards may be collected at the pool at the start of the season.
5. Membership includes free swim at public sessions and reduced rates at special sessions.
6. Gold membership affords free entry to morning and evening swims.
7. Duplicate tickets if lost £1. Please ask about our instalment plan.

Gift Aid Notes

1. **You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax the charity reclaims on your membership donation in the tax year.** (approximately 28p for each £1 you give)
2. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the charity.
3. If, in future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note1).
4. If you pay tax at a higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment return.
5. If you are unsure whether your membership donation qualifies for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the charity. Or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR 65.
6. Please notify us if you change your name or address.

Conditions, Rules and Code of Conduct

1. **The facilities are available to members only.**
2. There are three types of membership:
Full: Available to 18 years and over.
Junior: Available to 17 years and under, whose legal guardian has accepted all the conditions and signed the application form.
Temporary day: For visitors paying the appropriate fee, signing the visitors book and accepting the conditions.
3. **All members enter the pool at their own risk.** No responsibility for loss, damage, injury or accident will be accepted by the club or committee members.
4. The following must at all times be accompanied by a responsible person of 18 years or over:
 - i) Junior members under 9 years.
 - ii) Temporary day members under 12 years.
5. The committee member on duty reserves the right to restrict admission of members when the pool is busy.
6. The committee member on duty reserves the right to close the pool if:-
 - i) They are the only responsible adult on the premises.
 - ii) The number of bathers falls below 5.
 - iii) The weather or water temperature are not conducive to safe swimming.
 - iv) As a result of an accident or injury.
7. **The club does not undertake to provide a qualified lifesaver.**
8. Non swimmers, as assessed by the pool attendant, are not allowed beyond the half way point.
9. Membership cards are not transferable.
10. Code of Conduct, see also pool rules displayed at the pool
 - a) Membership tickets must be shown on every entry. **No ticket no entry.**
 - b) Diving is only allowed in the designated area, not the shallow end
 - c) Running, throwing, pushing and bombing are not allowed.
 - d) Members must be fully clothed, including shoes before leaving.
 - e) Long hair must be tied back.
 - f) The pool is a smoke free area.
 - g) Dogs, except guide dogs, radios, cassette players and musical instruments are prohibited.
 - h) The pump room is out of bounds.
 - i) No photography during public sessions.
 - j) **Glass is prohibited.** Litter to be placed in bins provided.
11. Any breach of these Rules or Code of Conduct could result in the members being barred from further swimming that day. Persistent nuisance could result in temporary or permanent expulsion from the club without refund.
