

## **Wiveliscombe Parish Council's Report to Annual Parish Meeting April 2008**

The Chairman reported that the Parish Council had had a busy year with meetings every month which had been well attended. At times planning matters had dominated meetings with a number of large applications for developments in the town and the Parish Council are currently discussing the relocation of the doctors' surgery with the Primary Care Trust. Highways matters continue to be a concern and the Parish Council are discussing the possibility of increasing the Croft Way Car Park capacity with Taunton Deane. Dog fouling continues to be a problem in the town and the Parish Council have pressed for increased visits from the Dog Warden. The Parish Council have been regularly visited by our County Councillor and one visit from the Leader of the District Council. The Children's Centre at Croft Way is due to open shortly and the Parish Council have supported the appointment of a Youth Worker for the area.
